The City of Joliet's existing water source is unsustainable, and it's time to select a new source. With the need for the City Council to make a decision in January 2020, NOW is the time to add YOUR voice to the discussion.

The need is clear. At the current rate of usage, Joliet's existing water source, the deep well aquifer, will no longer be sustainable by 2030. With that in mind, the City has been studying alternative water sources since August 2018. An initial list of 14 potential alternatives has been reduced

to five: Illinois River, Kankakee River, Lake Michigan – DuPage Water Commission, Lake Michigan – Chicago Department of Water Management, and Lake Michigan – New Indiana Intake.

The Phase II study, which analyzed each alternative for cost, sustainability, water quality, governance, and risk, has been completed and the draft report is available on the website at RethinkWaterJoliet.org/Reports. This information will be presented at the December 5, 2019 Public Forum and the City requests YOUR INPUT at the meeting.
